



- 21. The Institute shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form, in the light of directions of Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition No. © 656/1998 and norms as stipulated by the UGC.
- 22. The Institution shall remain bound by the norms, rules and regulations formulated by the University in respect of the conditions of affiliation, course & fee structure, syllabi content and academic regulations governing the conduct of the course(s) and shall pay fees / charges to be fixed by the University in respect of inspection, affiliation, registration of students, examination fees, etc. including any subsequent changes therein introduced by the University from time to time.

In the event of closure of the institution, the Organizing Society / Trust will not close Institution till the last batch of students admitted in the academic programmes complete the total duration of their respective academic programmes (i.e. 2 years, 3 years, 4 years etc. as the case may be).



23. The University will have no financial liability whatsoever for conducting the course(s).

Any infringement / contravention / non-compliance of the conditions mentioned above may lead to withdrawal of affiliation. All liabilities arising out of such withdrawal would solely rest upon to that of organizing Trust / Society. After completion of the academic year (2024 - 2025), the Institute will seek renewal of affiliation course-wise for the year (2025 - 2026).

Recommendation:

1. Driveway must be free of any type of obstruction for easy movement of Fire Appliances. No parking will be allowed on the drive way.

2. Entrance/Exits as marked in the sanctioned plan drawing must be open & free from any type of obstruction.

3. The Interior finish decoration of the building shall be made with low flame spread material confirming to the I.S. Specification.

4. To eliminate risk of Fire Hazards, Good House Keeping both for inside and outside of the building shall be strictly

maintained.

5. Existing Electrical wiring of the whole building shall have to be carefully checked for any wear and tear in them. If required the old electrical lines shall be replaced with new electrical lines, cables shall always be laid in M.S. conduit pipes continuously bonded to the earth.

All fire pumps, alarm & detection system which is incorporated in the building kept in auto mode round the clock.
The notice of Fire Fighting and Evacuation from the building shall be prepared and displayed at all vulnerable of

the building.

8. The employee and security staff shall be conversant with installed Fire Fighting equipment of the building and to operate in the event of Fire and Testing.

9. Mock Fire Practice and evacuation drill shall be performed periodically with participants of all the occupants of the building.

10. Switch gear room, Main & meter area shall be protected with Co2/DCP Fire Extinction conforming I.S. Specification.

11. First-Aid Fire Fighting system shall be provided as per I.S. Specifications.

12. Arrangement shall have to be made for regular checking, testing and maintenance of all the Fire Fighting installation in the building to keep them to perfectly good working condition at all times.

13. Periodical flashing of water from the hydrant and hose reel hose shall be done to maintain the efficient working performance of the system.

14. Sewerage pit covered of all around the building shall have to provide not less than 45 mt.

15. No obstruction shall have to allow all around driveway of the building like as greenery area, tree & car parking etc.

16. All floors of electrical ducts shall have to sealed as per norms.

17. Electrical main & meter room to be maintained all time proper safety measures.

18. Fire Safety Audit shall be conducted a regular interval and to be recorded in the Fire Prevention Maintenance Register.

19. Emergency lighting system (battery backup) to be installed in the stair case for the safe evacuation.

20. A fire control room including a close circuit T.V. system will have to be installed which will observe all the floors of the building.

This Fire Safety Certificate is valid for Three years and has to be renewed before expiry of the date of issue of this letter.






